

# What can you apply for?

### **Funding available**

Grants between £5k and £20k
available per project
- Max £1282.42 per participant for
Dorset

### **Participants**

Work with those who are:

- Economically inactive (priority) or unemployed
  - 16 years or older
- Are eligible to work in the UK

#### Where

Projects taking place in one of the following LEP/LEAP areas:

London North & East
Thames Valley Berkshire
Dorset – Dorset and
Bournemouth, Poole and
Christchurch Councils

### Your organisation

Third Sector Organisations and Small Organisations are eligible to apply.

#### What

Provide activities that will bring them closer to the labour market (into education or employment)

#### **Additional aims**

Ensuring funding is accessed by grassroots and smaller organisations whose size or activities might mean they may not access mainstream ESF monies.







# Priority groups

Those over 50 years of age;

with disabilities;

**Ethnic Minorities; and** 

women.

#### **Dorset**

Those in rural areas and within isolated pockets in urban areas who face barriers to accessing the labour market. Especially young people in rural area.

### **Thames Valley Berkshire**

Residents in areas of multiple deprivation and people in particular communities of interest (rather than geographically focused), who share common barriers to economic and social inclusion.

#### **London North and East**

Parents/mothers, carers, BAME groups, migrants and refugees, homeless, ex-offenders.









# Project examples

- First contact engagement activities, e.g. activities that benefit Participants who are not normally in contact with official organisations.
- Projects to improve confidence, motivation and social integration such as sport, gardening, music, art and other creative activities.
- Developing local networks and groups to support people to get a job or access learning e.g. Job Clubs or Learning Champion type activity.
- Softer skills development e.g. assertiveness, anger management and motivation.
- Innovative approaches to attract underrepresented Participant groups into learning.







# Live project examples

Child Workforce Taster
Courses
£20,000, 12 months.

Providing training and routes into childcare roles, particularly for lone parents.

Includes recruitment, English and maths and accreditations. **Crumbs Professional Training Programme £16,000, 12 months** 

In Dorset, Crumbs
Professional Training
Programme works with
adults with disabilities to
develop skills in
hospitality.

Offers practical training opportunities to build experience.

Hear Me Out £20,000, 12 months.

Assisting those who are deaf or hard of hearing into employment, including assistance with phone calls, BSL translation, ensuring proper arrangements made in role and funding accessed where necessary.
