Public Fundraising

- Good Hygiene and sanitation principles
- Maintain social distancing (2m or 1m+ mitigation)
 - Signage and floor markings
 - Give way to the public
 - Stay still
 - Review methods for exchanging items
- Be polite and respectful, do not apply undue pressure and be mindful of how the public may respond to your fundraising
- Review how you process donations
- Review how you collect donor information
