

Funding Update

- [**Dorset Coronavirus Community Response Grant - Phase 2.**](#) Grants of up to £2K, £5K and £10K. to support those suffering hardship as a result of the short and long term economic and social consequences caused by COVID-19 and to replace loss of income caused directly by Covid-19 where services/activities are being delivered and align with Fund priorities. **Deadline 28th August.**
- [**Lloyds Bank Foundation Covid 19 Recovery Fund opening on 3rd August.**](#) Open to small and medium sized charities that are helping people overcome complex social issues such as mental health, homelessness and domestic abuse. It will fund around 140 charities providing a two-year unrestricted grant of £50,000 and the support of a Development Partner. **Deadline 11th September**
- [**People's Postcode Trust**](#) provides project based funding of up to £20K depending on your legal structure under the themes 'Promoting human rights, Combatting discrimination and Preventing poverty'. **Deadline 19th August**

Funding Update

- [Arts Council England Project Grants Re-Open for Applications.](#) Grants of up to £100K are available for arts, museums and libraries projects that engage people with arts and culture. In light of the impact COVID-19 has had on the sector, the programme will aim to support individuals and organisations to get activities up and running again, and help people re-engaged with culture and creativity.
- [Arts Council England Emergency Grassroots Music Venues Fund](#) - A one-off government grant scheme, being administered by Arts Council England, is offering grants of between £1,000 and £80,000 for grassroots music venues, such as community centres, village halls and pubs, that are at imminent risk of insolvency due to COVID-19. **Deadline Monday, 3 August**
- [The Foyle Foundation Main Grants Scheme](#) - **reopened.** Capital and revenue grants of £10K to £50K are available for performing or visual arts, as well as projects that help with the acquisition of knowledge and learning. The criteria has been revised to take into account the impact of COVID-19 e.g. covering core costs, building adaptations to enable social distancing, equipment to support digital delivery or homeworking.
