### Let's Focus on: Our Policies Support for you

Are you managing risk properly?

Don't let your policies get out-of-date!

Policies and procedures are the main ways in which organisations make sure that problems don't occur, and, if they do, that everyone knows what to do. For instance, safeguarding; does everyone know how to deal with incidents? Are you managing your data properly? Do you have procedures in place to avoid scams and cyber-crime? A major incident could ruin your reputation and create problems with your funders.

You should review your procedures regularly to ensure that risks are mitigated and that you have the proper procedures in place, especially the "Big Five"; Health & Safety, Safeguarding, GDPR, Organisational Risk and Financial Processes.

## Seed2Plate Updates from the Garden



Happy New Year from Seed2Plate!

Although winter seems a quiet time in the garden, there is a lot of work going on underneath the soil as the plants build their food sources and root systems ready for spring.

There is also a lot going on behind the scenes as we plan our planting lists for the Community Courtyard Kitchen and Wellbeing Garden, including a mix of sensory planting, wildlife friendly blooms and pick your own beds all growing together in a potager style garden. We have ordered new tables, chairs and benches to provide seating areas and with the help of our volunteers have started to rearrange and clear the space.

We have received a small pot of funding to start off a new plot in Somerford, Christchurch. This will be an area for the local community to learn how to grow their own food and to help young people get involved in outdoor horticulture activities. In light of the current cost of living crisis, we will also be running FREE Warm & Well workshops in Somerford which will focus on a variety of things including energy-efficient ways to cook and to help get the most out produce without breaking the bank.

We will be up and running again at our plots in Bridport and Littlemoor soon and have recently taken over a plot at Tumbledown Farm in Weymouth, so lots to do!! ### Free Hallmark assessment in May 2024

DCA has been funded in 2024 to offer the award of the ACRE Hallmark. The next round will be happening in the period March to May 2024. Having a Hallmark shows everyone, including potential funders, volunteers and users, that your hall is well-run. It celebrates what you do and helps you to get everything up-to-date. You can also get money off your insurance premiums.

### There are three Hallmarks:

- Hallmark 1 focuses on management and administration.
- Hallmark 2 focuses on health, safety, security and licences.
- Hallmark 3 requires the hall to be working with the community and its users, including stakeholders; marketing the hall and building its profile in the centre of the community (you will usually have finished 1 and 2 before tackling this.

Each one has a checklist for you to work through and involves a visit and an external assessment. If you are interested in knowing more, please see the Hallmark Project (this will necessitate a brief sign-up process) or email <u>caro.hart@dorsetcommunityaction.org.uk</u>

### Carbon Literacy training for community groups and parish and town councils:

Carbon literacy is "An awareness of the carbon costs and impacts of everyday activities and the ability and motivation to reduce emissions, on an individual, community and organisational basis."

The Carbon Literacy Project offers everyone a day's worth of Carbon Literacy® learning, covering climate change, carbon footprints, how you can do your bit and why it's relevant to you and your community. This project is globally unique and was recognised as such by the UN at COP21, in Paris, where it was awarded as a TAP100, one of 100 worldwide Transformative Action Programs. Participants find that they have:

- Gained an understanding of the basic science of climate change and how climate change will affect us both globally and locally
- Gained an understanding of how climate change will affect your local community.
- Created an action plan to help reduce the carbon footprint of your organisation and local area
- Gained an understanding of how you can mobilise change.
- Explored strategies for influencing others to take action on climate change.

Local organisations are banding together to deliver a Dorset-specific Carbon Literacy programme in two half days:

- Part one: Tues 13 Feb 9am 1pm
- Part two: is on Tues 6 Feb 1pm 5pm or Weds 7 Feb 9am 1pm or Weds 14 Feb 9am - 1pm

**Who can apply:** UK registered charities and UK universities working in the UK and/or overseas.

**How much?** Match Funding - Small, medium and large grants up to and over £50,000.

**Focusing on**: Maintaining, repairing and improving community buildings for people in need. Can include decorating the homes of people living with illness and disability.

Important dates: Deadline is Saturday 10th February.
